



Fig. 1. — Plan du sanctuaire de Claros à l'issue des fouilles de 1950-1961, éch. 1/1250.







Basic scheme of a Roman encampment (**castrum**). The gates were four: la praetoria, towards in enemy; the decumana, located on the opposite side; the dextera and the left. The **decumanus maximus** connected the praetoria and decumana doors, while **the cardo maximus** the dextera door to the left one. Coinciding with their intersection, the **praetorium usually stood, which later became the forum**








Fig. 1. — Plan du sanctuaire de Claros à l'issue des fouilles de 1950-1961, éch. 1/1250.






Fig. 1 – Le sanctuaire de Claros à la fin de l'époque hellénistique : plan général restitué des zones fouillées. Toutes les colonnes des temples d'Apollon et d'Artémis ont été représentées, bien qu'elles n'aient pas toutes été érigées






Fig. 1. — Plan du sanctuaire de Claros à l'issue des fouilles de 1950-1961, éch. 1/1250.





Fig. 1—Le sommaire de Clavos à la fin de l'époque hellénistique : plan général restitué des zones fouillées. Toutes les colonnes des temples d'Apollon et d'Artémis ont été représentées, bien qu'elles n'aient pas toutes été érigées






Fig. 237 Air view of the Olympieion and the excavated areas to the north (in the foreground) and to the south (upper right). Air view taken in 1963. (Greek Ministry of Housing).









- Its current significance is chiefly associated with the sanctuary of the goddess Despoina, which contained a colossal sculptural group perhaps made by [Damophon](#) of [Messene](#); this group comprises [acrolithic](#)-technique statues of Despoina and [Demeter](#) seated on a throne, with statues of [Artemis](#) and the [Titan Anytos](#) standing on either side of them - all in Pentelic marble.











FIG. I. PLAN OF THE STOA (SCALE 1 : 500)
